



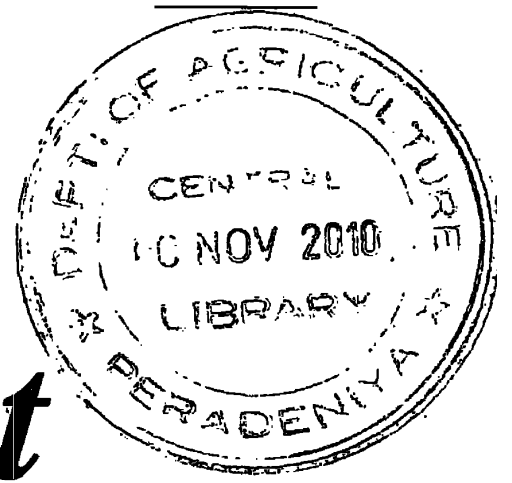

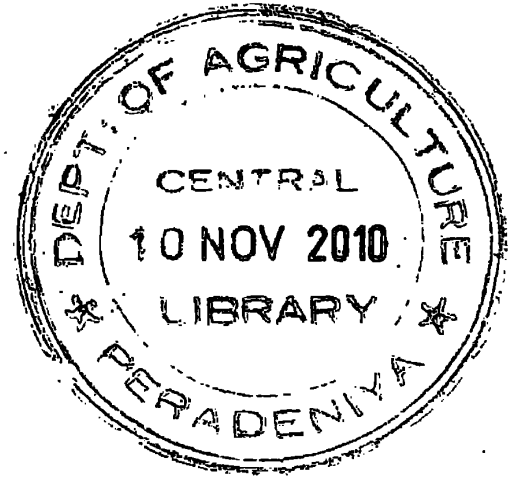

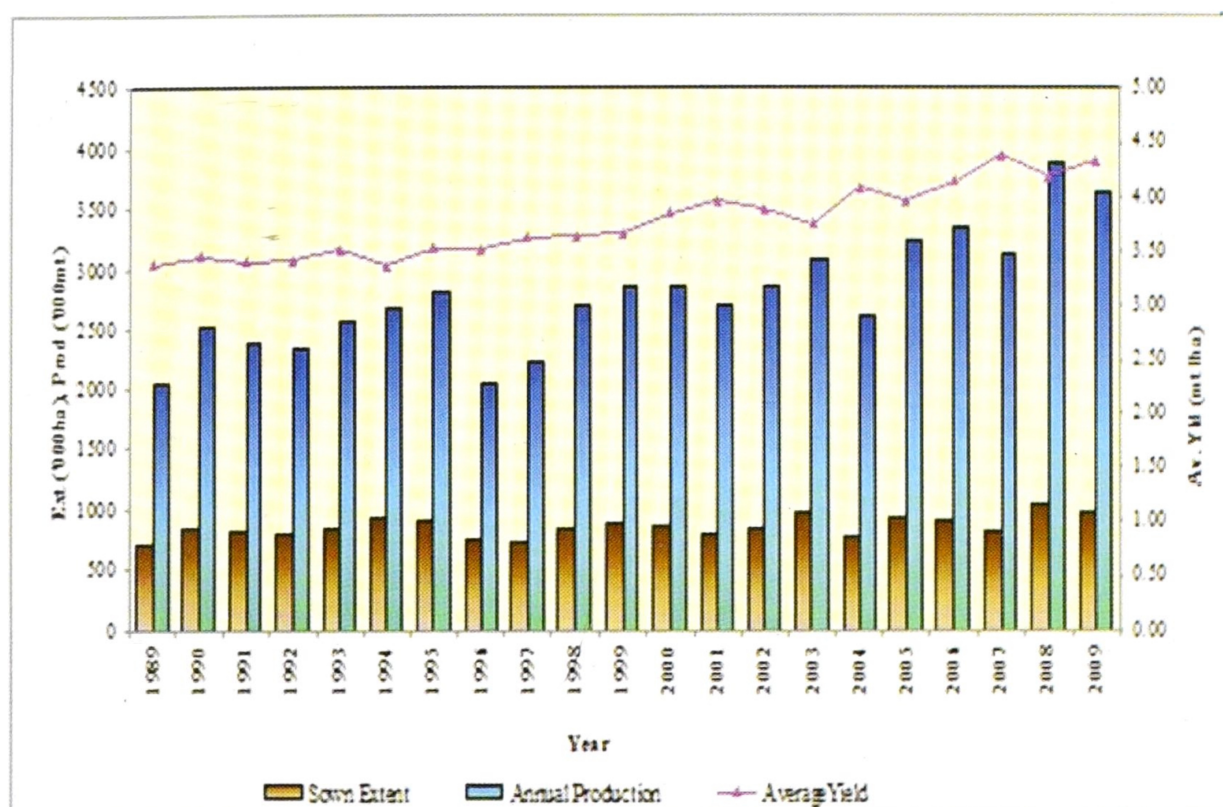


Figure 1: Trend in Extent, Production and Average Yield of Paddy 1989 - 2009

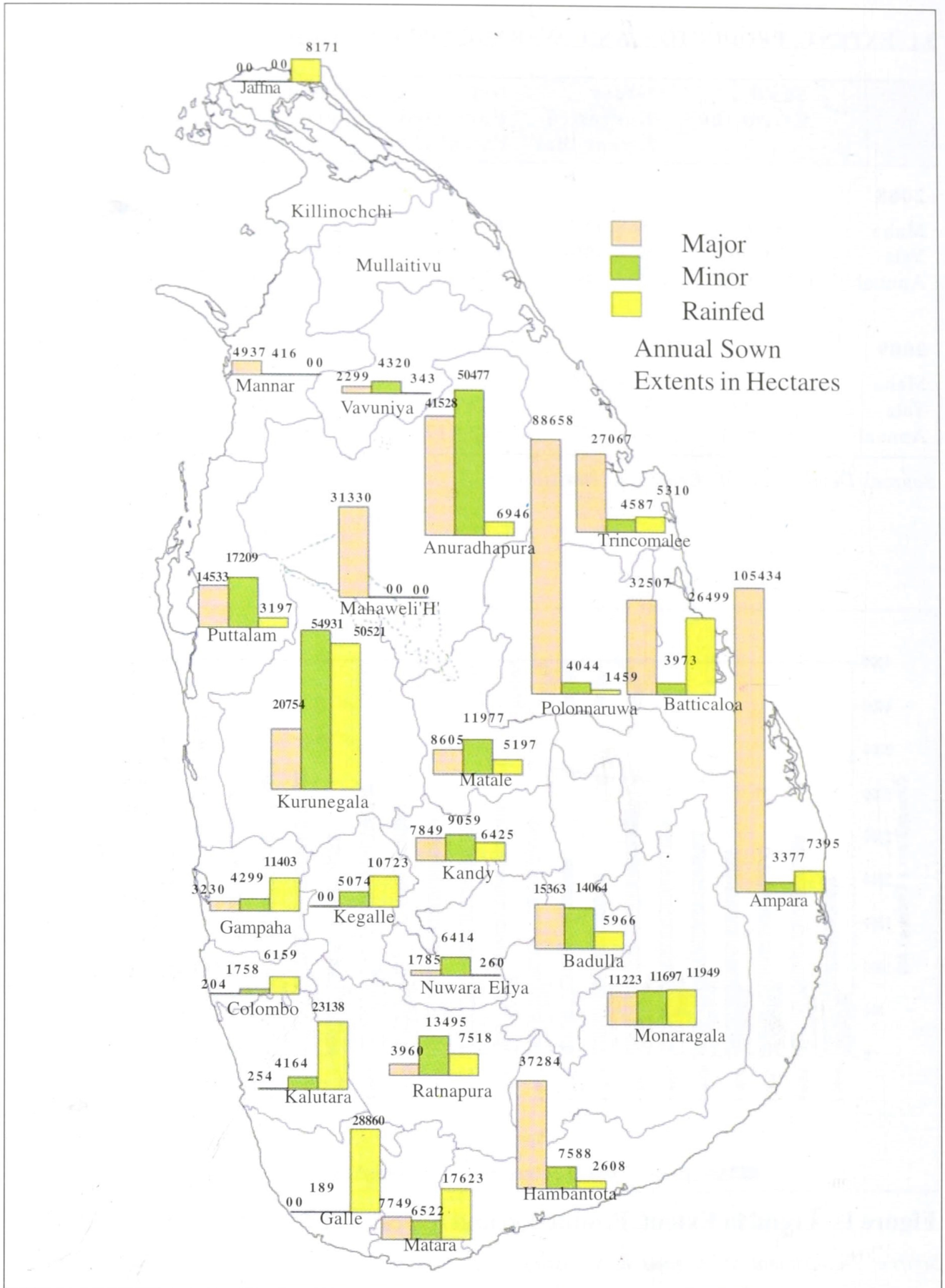


Figure 2 : Extents of Paddy - 2009

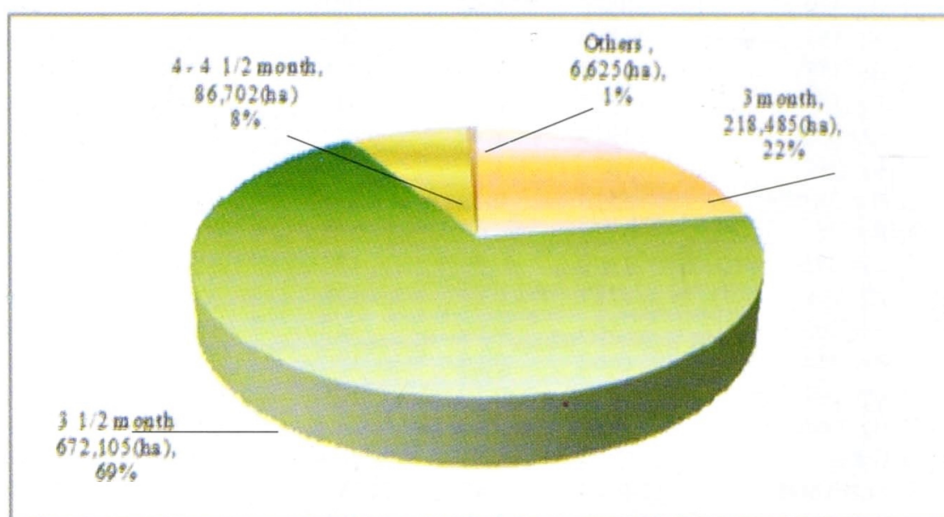


Figure 3: Varietal Distribution of Paddy - 2009

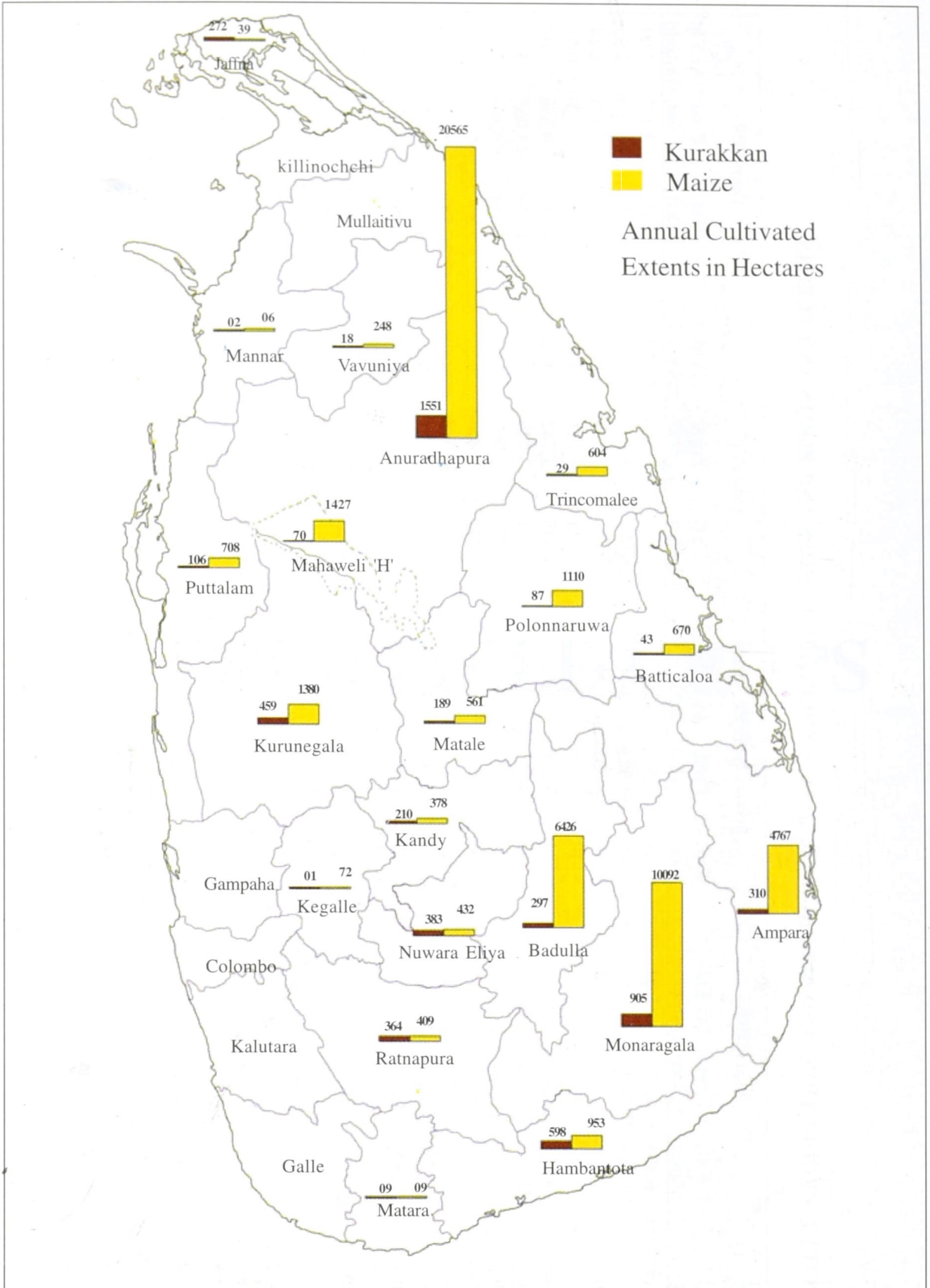


Figure 4: Extents of Cereals- 2009

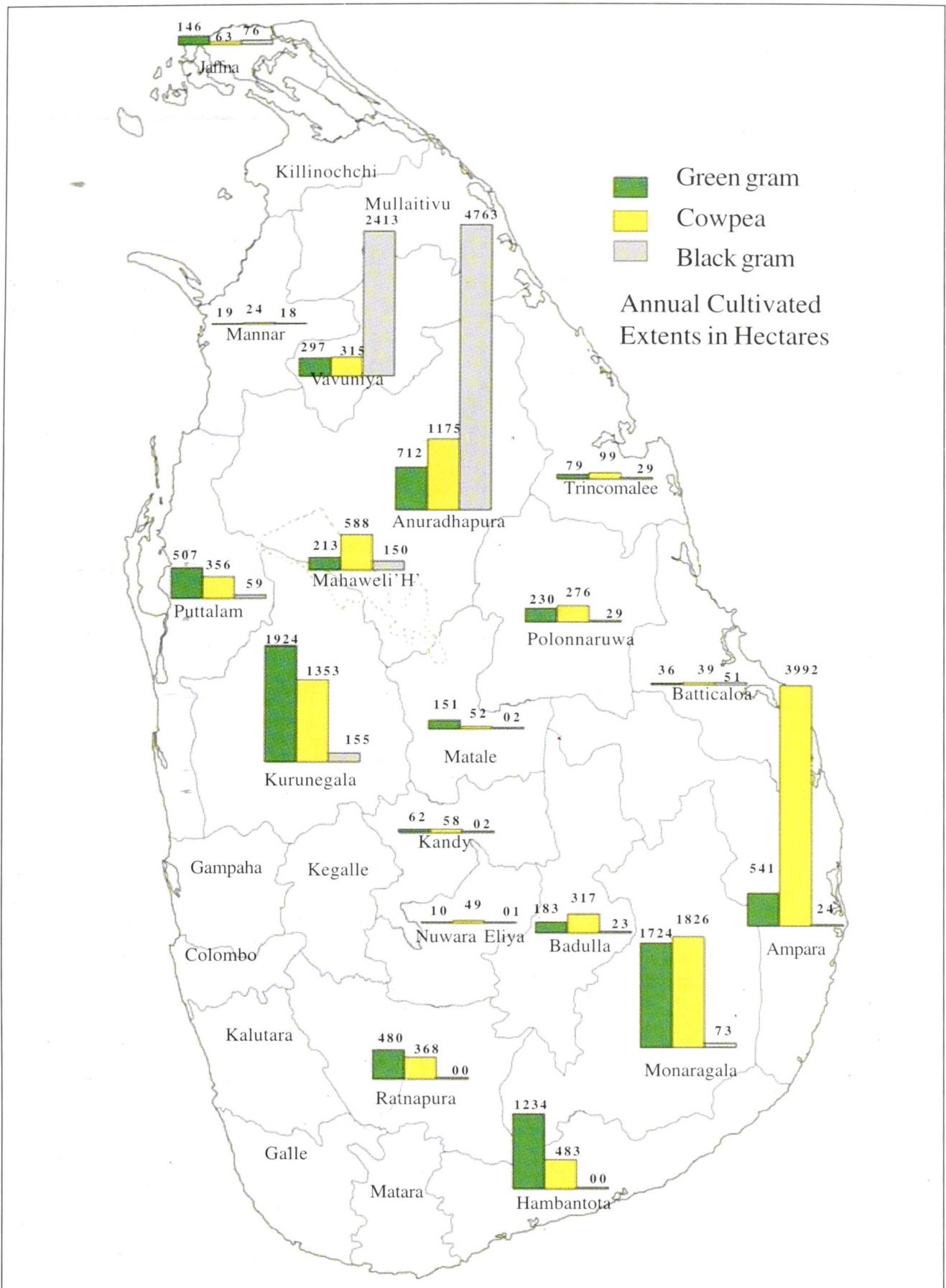


Figure 5: Extents of Pulsus- 2009

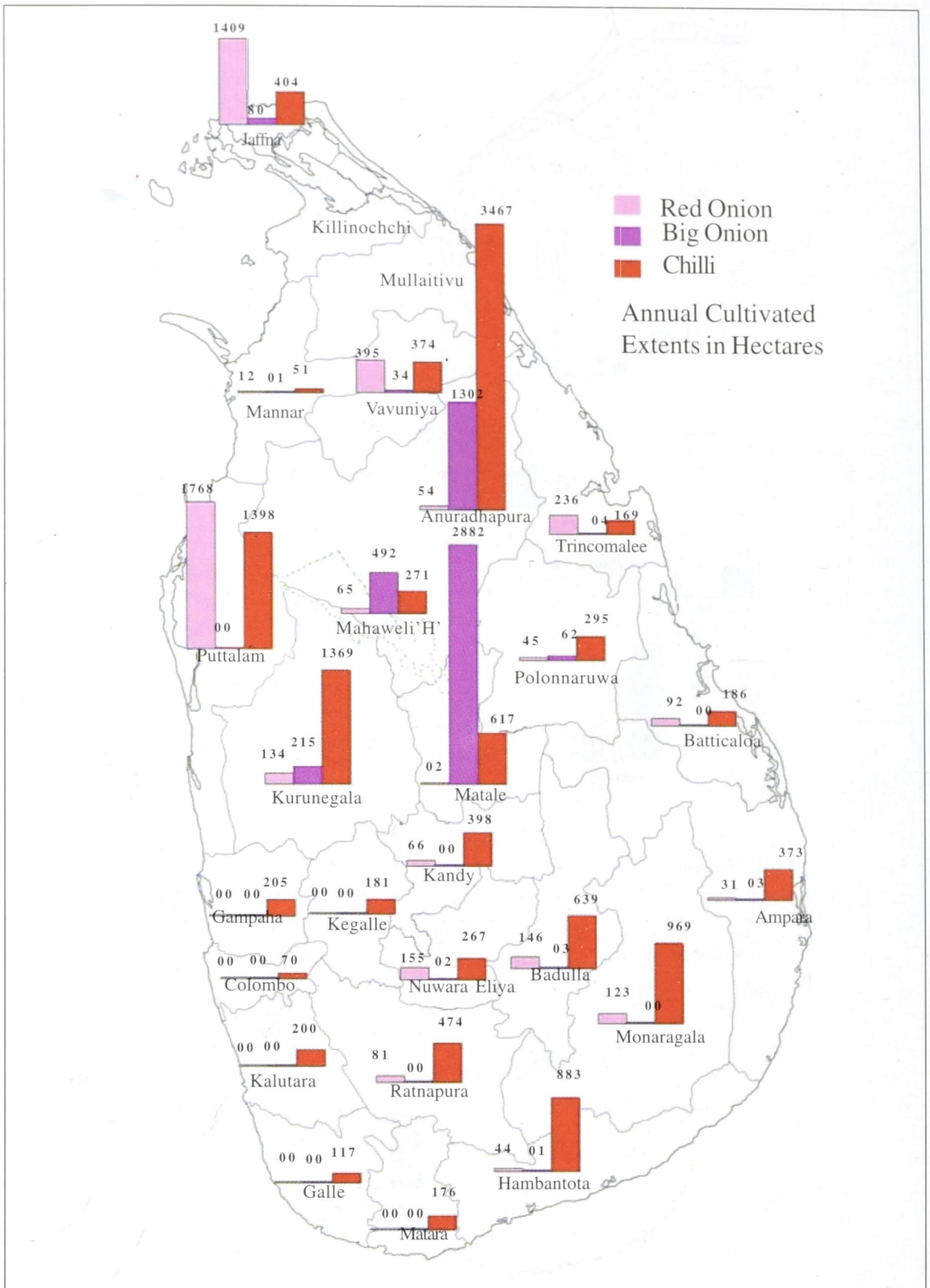


Figure 6: Extents of Condiments - 2009

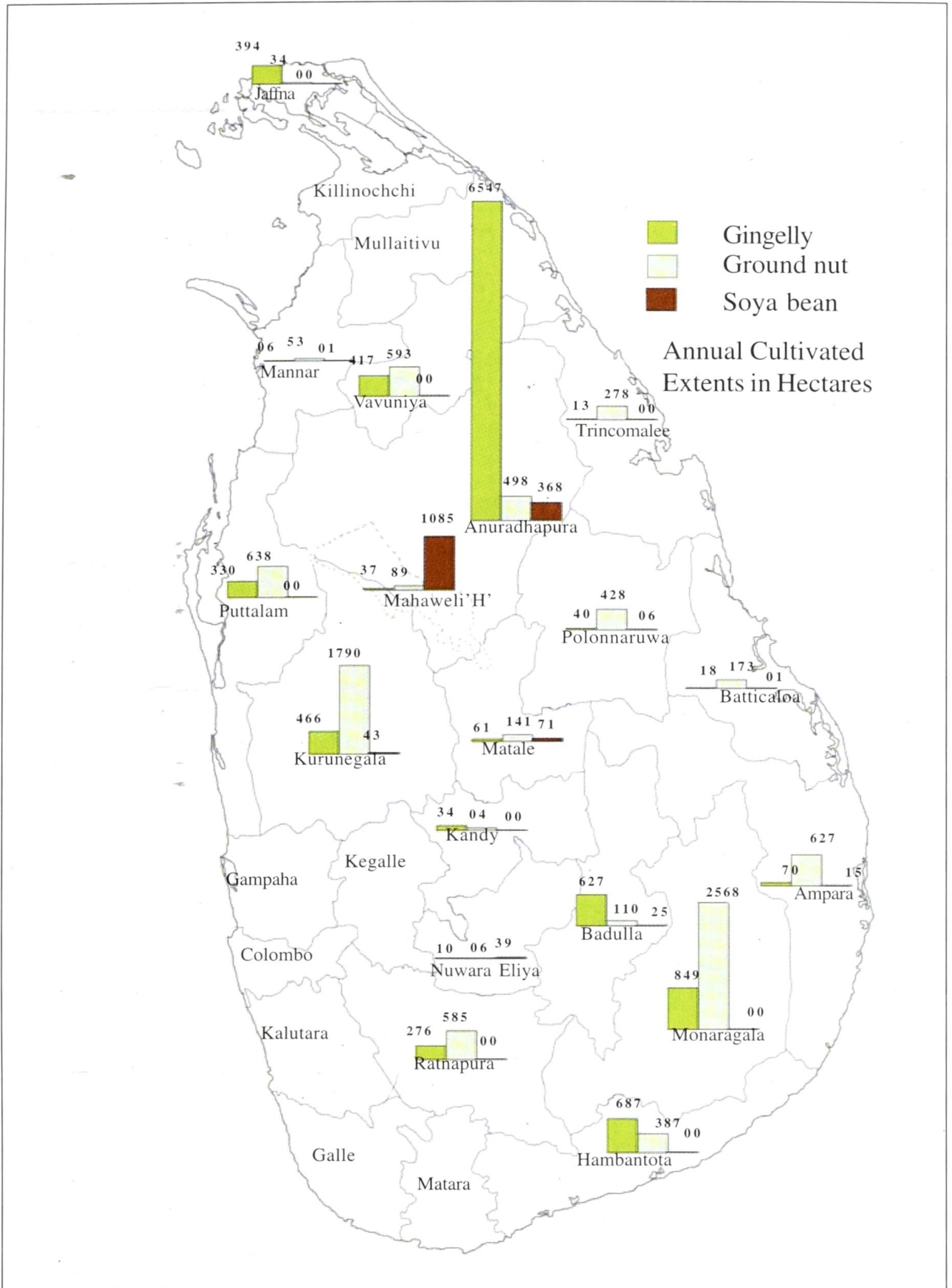


Figure 7: Extents of Oil Crops - 2009

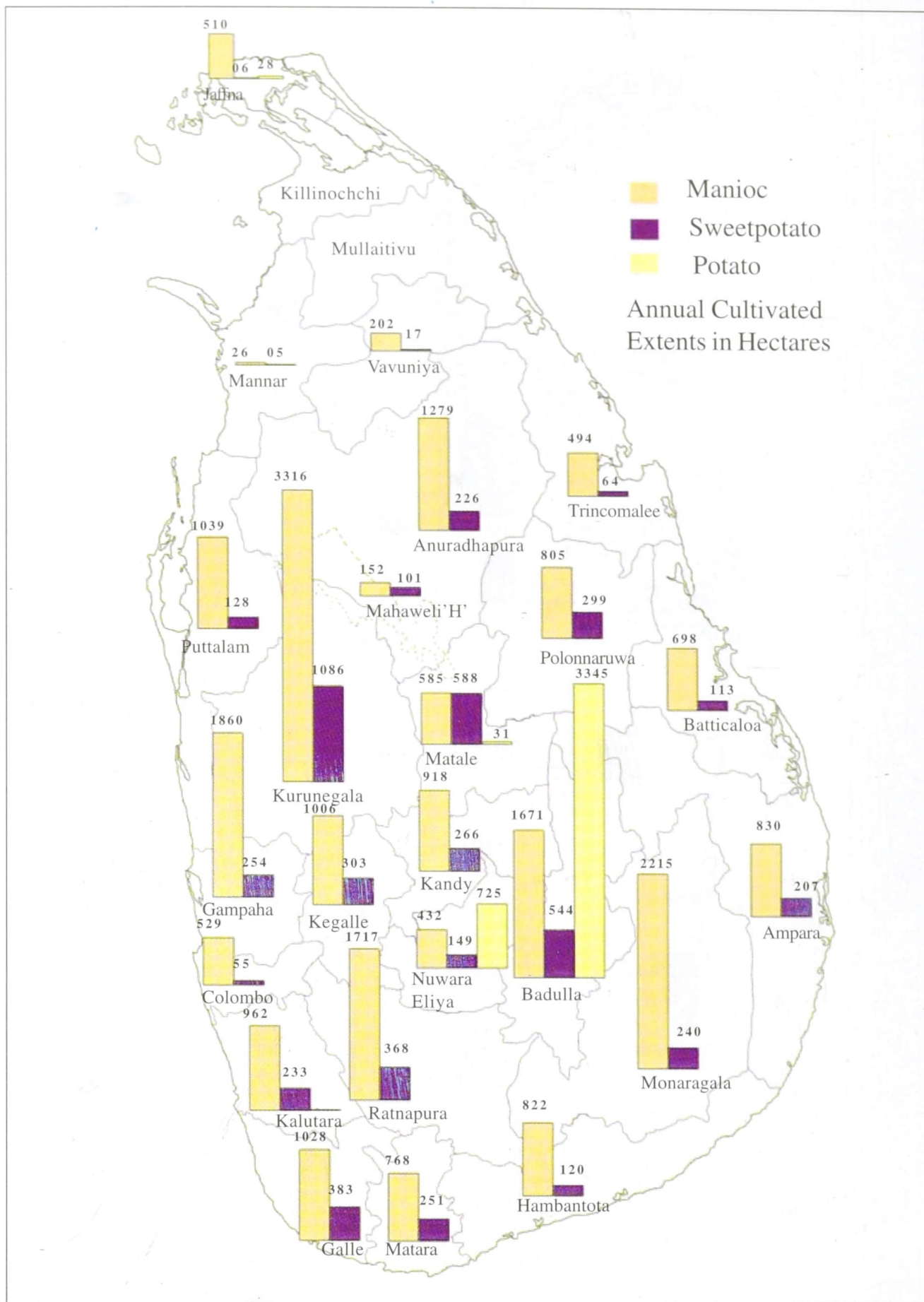


Figure 8: Extents of Root and Tuber Crops - 2009

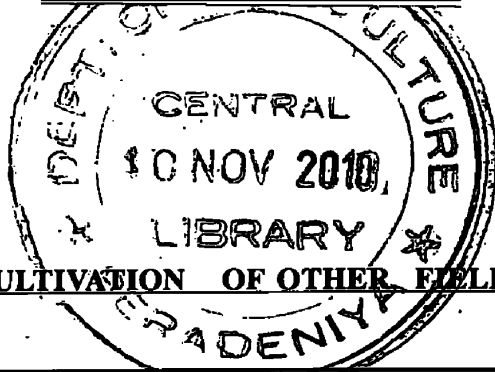

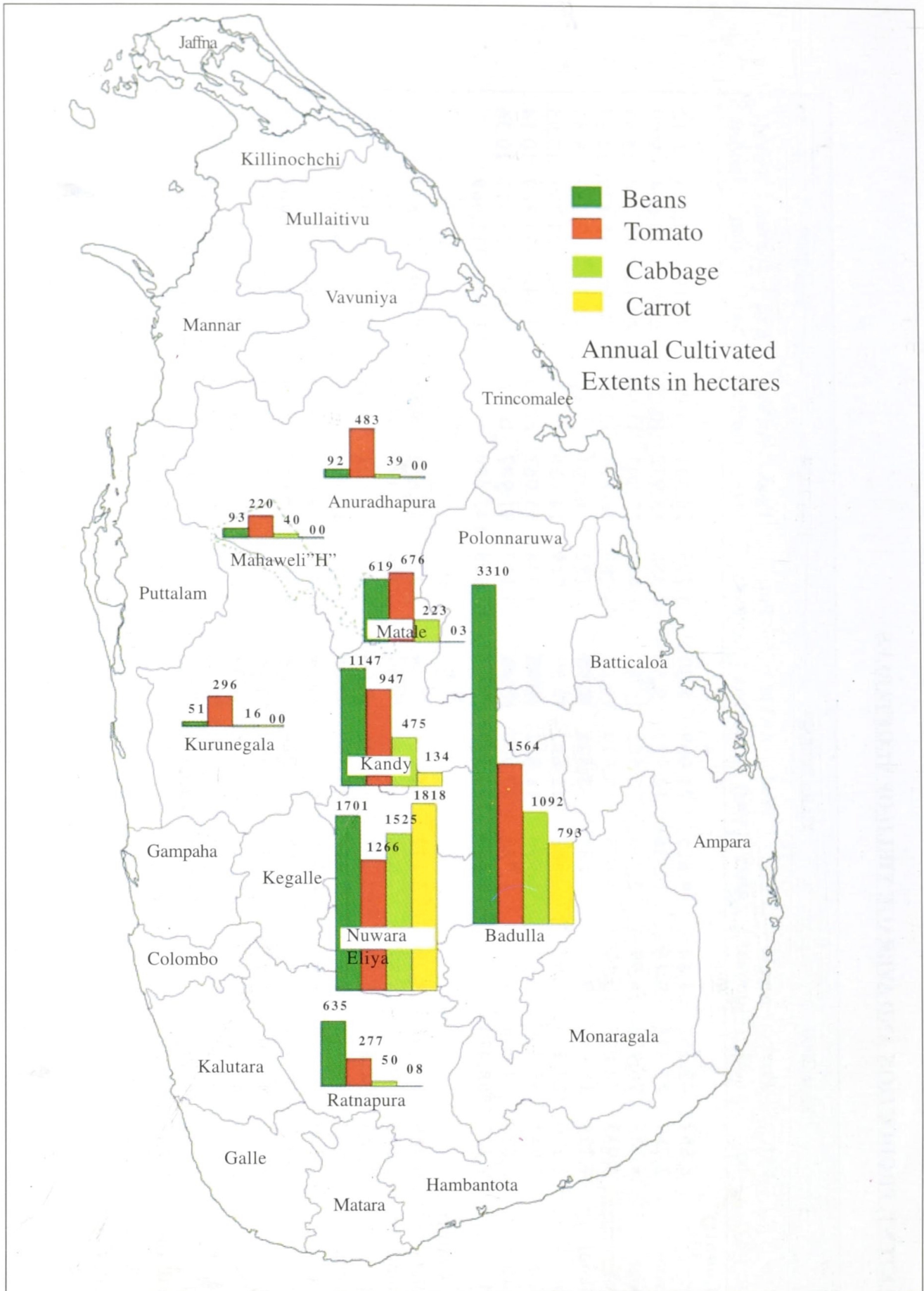


Figure 9: Extents of Up Country Vegetables - 2009

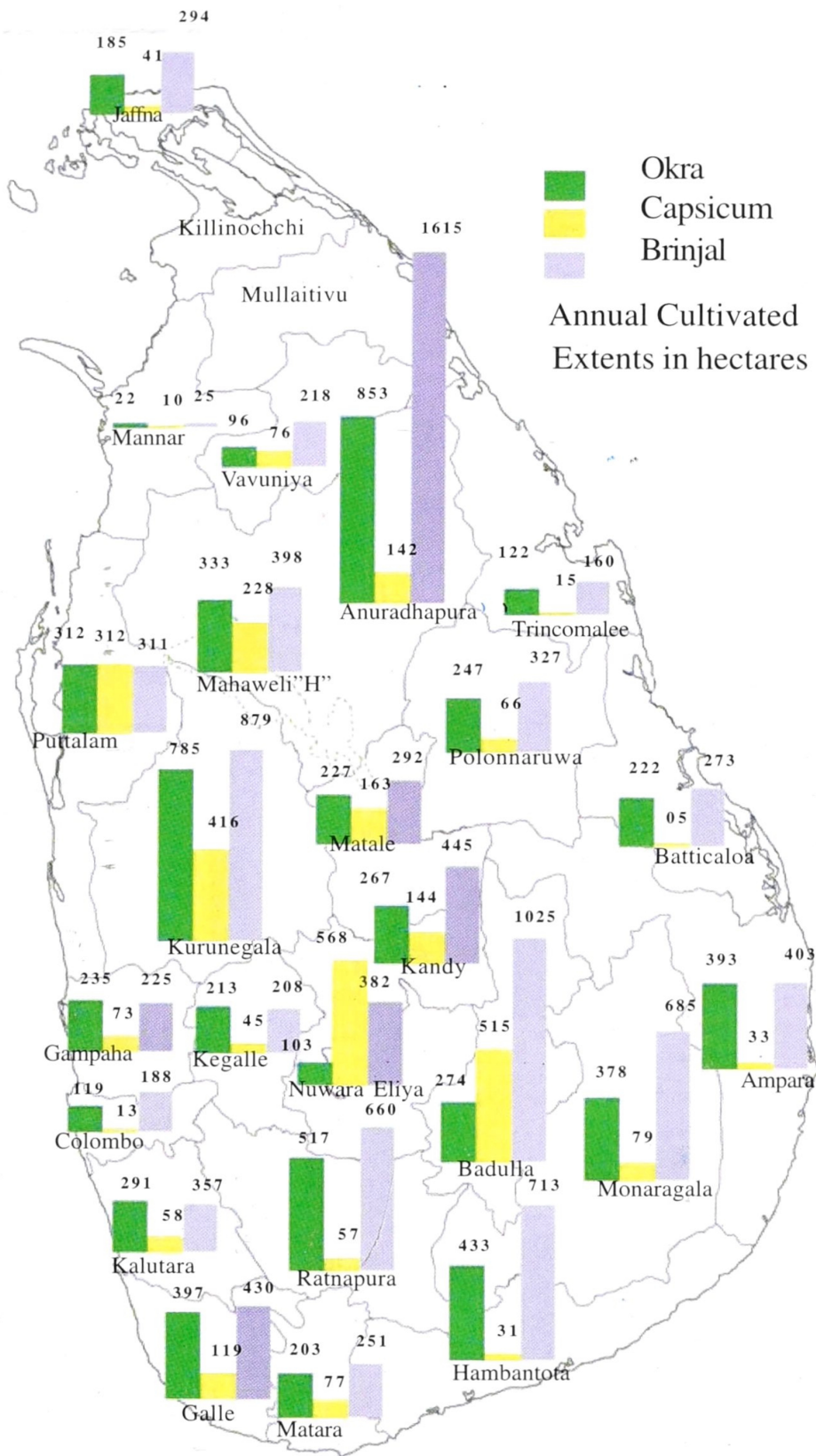


Figure 10a: Extents of Low Country Vegetables - 2009

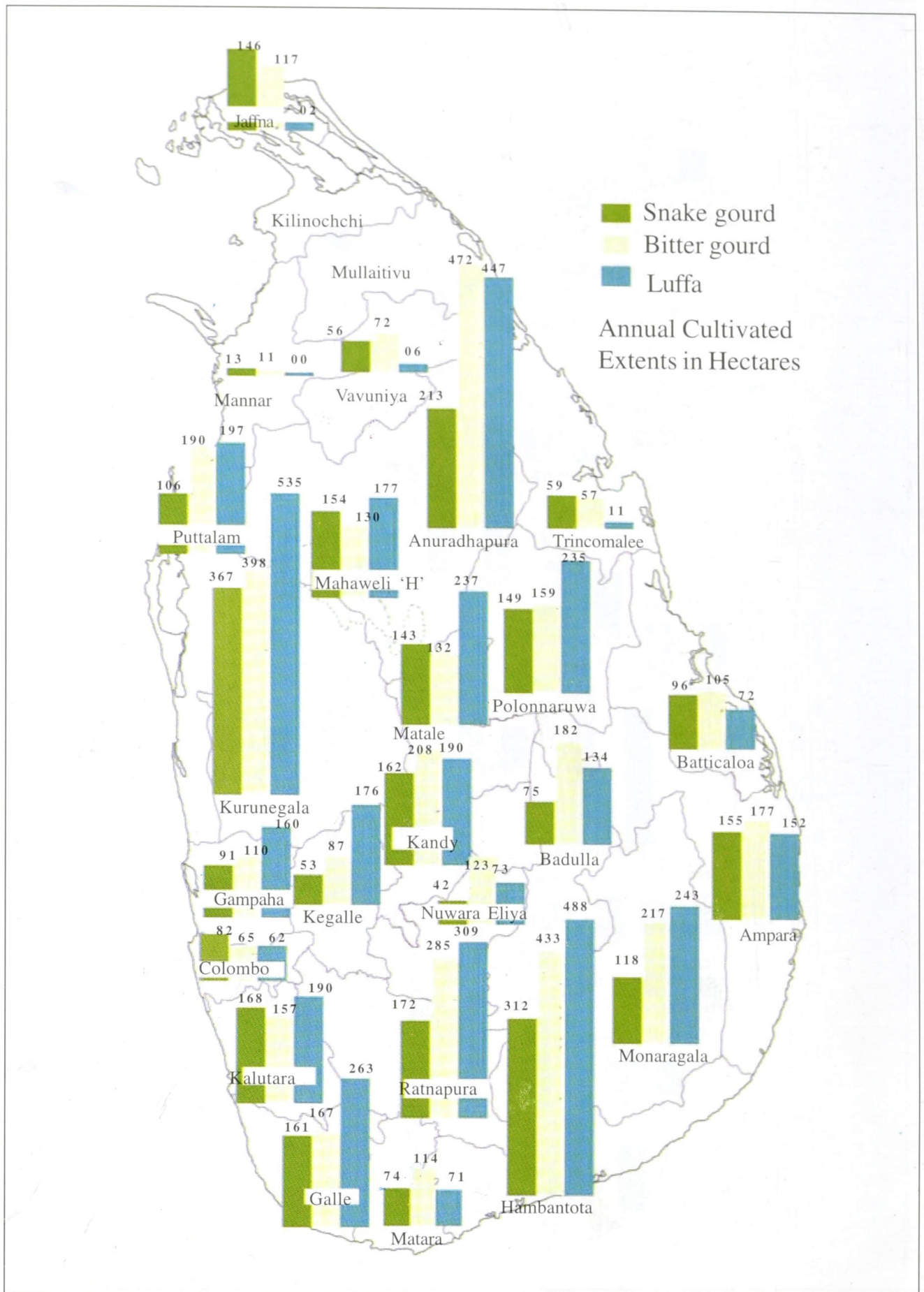


Figure 10 b: Extents of Low Country Vegetables- 2009

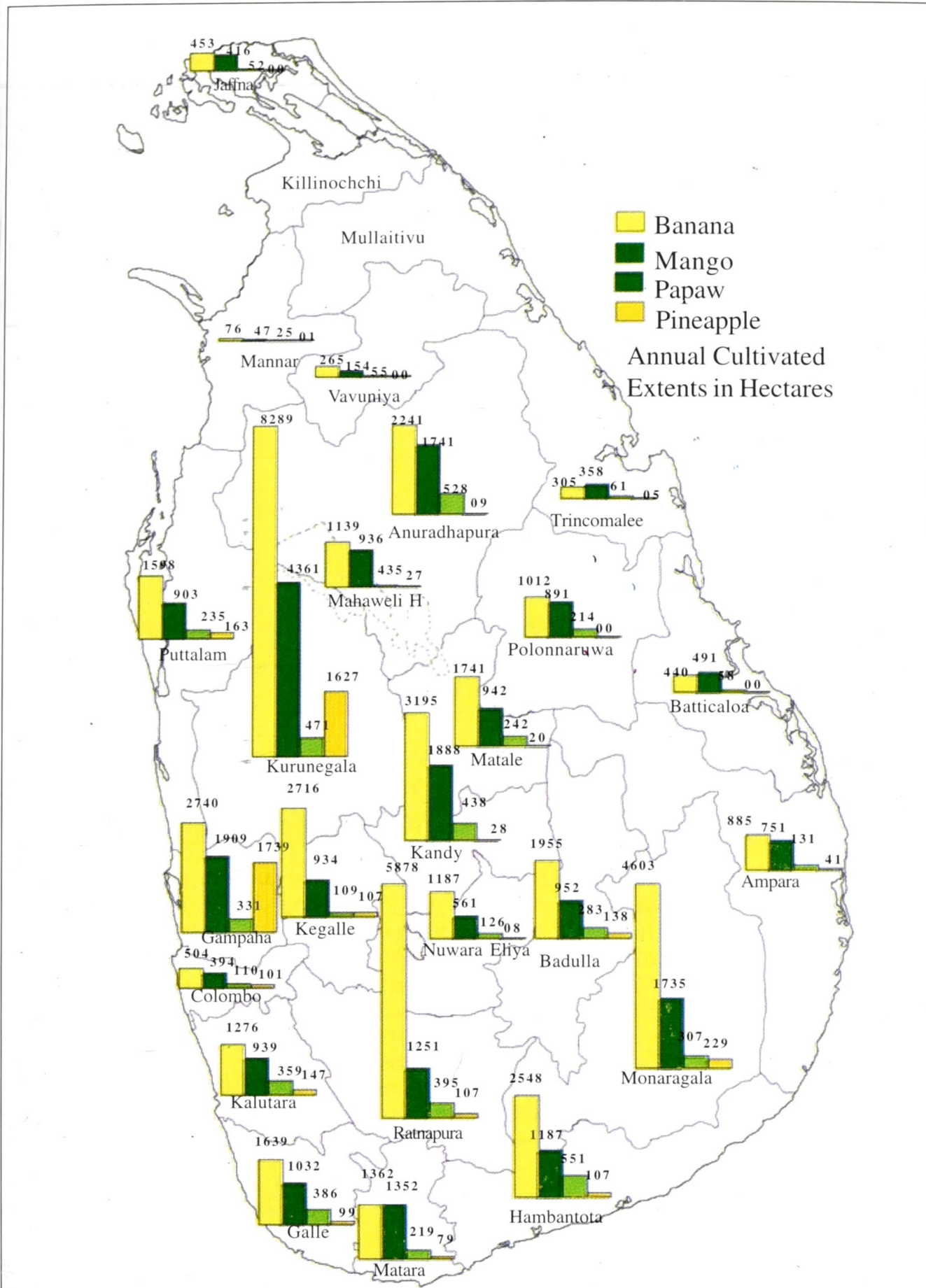


Figure 11: Extents of Fruits - 2009

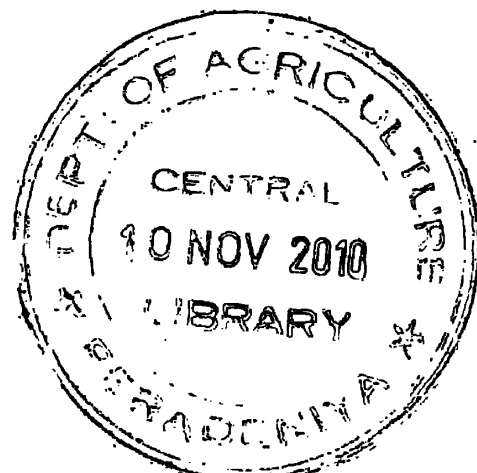
